Creek Valley Rainforest Retreat

On the edge of World Heritage rainforest, you will discover a modern 3-bedroom steel pole house situated on 4 hectares of land for wildlife wedged into Girringun National Park.

The retreat is nature based and ideal for relaxation - the peaceful privacy is perfect.

Creek Valley Rainforest Retreat is bordered by a pristine mountain-born rainforest stream with refreshing rock pools.

The retreat is totally secluded, yet only 20 minutes north of Ingham, a well supplied town with a strong Italian influence.

In our valley, the only sounds you will hear are those from wildlife and the running creek. You will either feel relaxed by its restful ripples or be in awe of a roaring runoff. Around dawn and dusk, you might notice warbling birds or be startled by their boisterous calls.

The creek provides critical habitat for the Mahogany Glider and the Southern Cassowary.



On a new moon, the nights are pitch dark revealing close to a thousand stars. For moon-lit nights, there is an outdoor fireplace with a grill set up in the centre of a paved area.



Accommodation is strictly non-smoking and suited for a maximum of 8 guests, ideally 4 adults and up to 4 children.

The steel pole home features two main bedrooms, privately positioned diagonally opposite each other; the master bedroom opens up to an en-suite with a double shower.

The third bedroom is designed for kids with a bunk bed, a single bed and a trundle. It is flanked by a second bathroom with a generous shower and by a separate toilet.

The fully equipped gourmet kitchen includes an espresso maker, double-filtered water and a dishwasher.

All rooms open on to a spacious living area with comfortable sofas and a dining table. A 4 metre wide, screened bi-fold door connects the living with a large shady veranda featuring a second 8-chair table setting.

Downstairs, beside the laundry, you will find a third toilet and an outdoor shower.

Creek Valley Rainforest Retreat

is at the foot of Mt Gardiner in the Cardwell range, 1.5 hours north of Townsville by road, just past Ingham, upstream of Arnot Creek.

The nearby Hinchinbrook Channel is known as a fishing mecca, the restored Tyto Wetlands form a birdwatchers paradise and the historic Dalrymple Gap Track is a must for hikers.

The region also claims the world's highest single drop waterfall in Wallaman Falls and the longest jetty (for raw sugar) at Lucinda. Forrest Beach and Taylors Beach provide sandy shores and shady playgrounds.



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
